Prayer request for the week:

PGA Team will be leaving for another medical and dental missions tonight at 10 p.m. taking the ferry boat to Tubigong, Bohol - a neighboring island in Cebu. Please remember us in prayers. After Tubigong, we will still travel by land for about 45 minutes to have the clinic in one of the church in Carmen. Carmen is a mountainous town of Bohol where most of the New People's Army (NPA-army rebels) are so visible in their operations. We will be arriving Bohol at 12 midnight but will have to wait until 4 a.m. to disembark from the ferry. The host pastor called this afternoon and decided that we move out when it's getting day light. There have been some incidents these past months where vehicles passing late at night or during wee hours in the morning have been hold up by the NPA. So far, no news of any hostage taking. This evangelistic outreach clinic has been planned a year ago. We've prayed for it. God provided the supplies/medicines and everything. We believe He will be with us until we get back to Cebu tomorrow night - May 10th. Thank you so much once again for your prayers. After Bohol, there will be two other clinics for the this month of May. The team takes a "break" from all our summer activities for month before we resume on the last Saturday on June.
