You will have ample time at the beginning, traveling at a leisurely pace; all meals in Greece and Turkey are included, as well as all transportation, Biblical tours, hotels in central locations and just the right amount of fellowship and sights. The tour of Greece and Turkey is geared at a leisurely pace where you will have ample time to explore on your own, too. If you have more time, you can do the optional Rome extension. In Rome, you will see the most important Biblical sites and stay in a very central location in order to see the other beautiful monuments of the Eternal City.

The core tour begins at only \$4,689 per person. Paying a little bit more will get you an outside cabin or balcony cabin. The cruise ship we will be on is called the Celestyal Olympia. 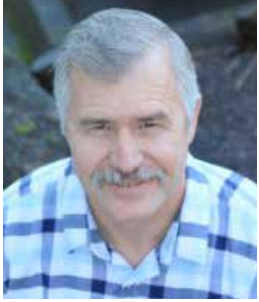

- APRIL 27:** Coliseum, Arch of Titus, the Forum and Palatine Hill, Mamertine Prison Museum (where Paul and Peter were incarcerated). St Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel.

ITINERARY IN DETAIL [INCL. MEALS: B=BREAKFAST / L=LUNCH / D=DINNER]

APRIL 19: Depart Portland on your overnight flight to Athens – meals are served on-board the flights. **[B/L/D]**

APRIL 20: Arrival in Athens, transfer to our hotel, located in the historic center. Once we have checked in, we will walk together in Attica via the quaint streets of Plaka. We will stop and have a lovely, outdoor dinner under twinkling lights and the commanding Acropolis. **[D]**

APRIL 21: We meet our guide this morning and the first stop is the famous Athens Acropolis. We will have a teaching at the little rock hill called the Areopagus (Mars Hill). This is where Paul made his famous Mars Hill sermon. Visit the Agora, Hadrian's Arch, stop at the first Olympic Stadium and see Constitution Square. Overnight in Athens with dinner. **[B/L/D]**

APRIL 22: Today we will drive to the ancient City of Corinth. Here we will see the site of this important Early Church and see the synagogue where Paul spoke and at the Bema where he stood. Stop at the Corinth Canal, enjoy a Greek, farm lunch and then return to Athens for a free afternoon. Dinner included, once again. **[B/L/D]**



APRIL 23: Sleep-in this morning and then board your cruise ship for lunch. After familiarizing yourself with our new home, we have a fun stop! We arrive in Mykonos, Greece. This island, famous for its windmills, beaches and famous seaside restaurants, can be explored all evening. Come back aboard for a late dinner and then we sail away. **[B/L/D]**

APRIL 24: This morning, we arrive at the most important of the “Seven Churches of Revelation”, the site of Ephesus, where we will have a Bible-focused tour. Return to the ship for lunch. In the afternoon, we visit the precious island of Patmos. We have a tour today of the island where we will visit the cave where the Apostle John received the Book of Revelation. You have time to enjoy the water front, have an ice cream or do a little shopping. Dinner and sail on. **[B/L/D]**

APRIL 25: We arrive at the Greek island of Crete, another important stop on Paul's journey. We will visit the important Archaeological Museum and learn of the significance of this large island, then rejoin the ship for lunch. This afternoon, our ship arrives at Santorini. Though not Biblical, the visit to this island is always a highlight! It is considered by many one of the most beautiful places on earth! Free time to sit and enjoy amazing views, ride bicycles, take a 4-Wheel adventure, swim, or just wander around its quaint shops. Enjoy your last night aboard ship as we sail away after dark.

APRIL 26: Disembark ship and transfer directly to the airport for your flight to Rome to join the optional Rome extension below) or fly back to Portland, arriving the same day. **[B]**



OPTIONAL POST-TOUR EXTENSION: ROME

APRIL 26: We depart Athens this morning on our flight to Rome. Upon arrival, you will be met and taken into the city, where there will be free time for lunch. You will then join your guide for a tour of the Catacombs of the Early Church. This is where the Early Christians hid and lived during the times of persecution. We will also visit the church called "Paul's Outside the Walls," which is where the Apostle Paul is buried. Enjoy the neighborhood of your Roman city and then join us for pizza tonight at a festive restaurant. **[B/L/D]**

APRIL 27: This morning, we visit the Coliseum, which is built by the revenue from the gold of the Temple at Jerusalem when it was destroyed. We then visit the important Arch of Titus which documents this, then onto

the Forum and Palentine Hill. In the same area, we will visit the underground precious prison now called the Mamertine Museum. This is the prison where Paul was kept during his important Roman writings and where Peter was also held. You will have some free time for lunch and then we will visit St Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. Your evening is free to explore. **[B]**

APRIL 28: Free day and evening in Rome. Everything is so close: Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, the Pantheon. You will love every corner of the Eternal City! Join us for a farewell dinner. **[B/D]**

APRIL 29: Transfer to airport for flight back to Portland, arriving the same day. **[B/L/D]**

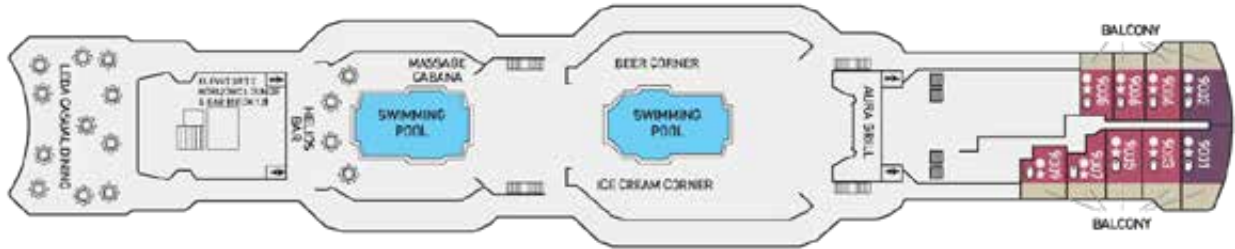

Your tour includes the cruise, Biblical tours of Athens, Corinth, Patmos, Ephesus ad Crete and Biblical tours of Rome, if you choose the extension. The core tour also includes round-trip air from Portland (with optional cities available – please email or call us for a quote), all air taxes and fuel surcharges, the cruise, their port taxes, all meals in Greece and Turkey, all transfers, transportation and hosting of its private tour. Tips are included during the cruise portion with a pre-collected amount for tips for other services. You can select from an inside cabin, an outside cabin or balcony cabin pricing. Primary pricing (double) is based on two people sharing a room. You can opt to have us help you find a roommate, you can find your own roommate, or you can opt to pay a higher rate and have a private room and cabin on the ship—referred to as a “single rate.” Once you have selected the core trip pricing, you will decide if you want to join us on the Rome extension. Another optional thing to consider is trip-cancellation insurance. The pricing is below and is determined by the total amount of your trip’s cost. This group will be a small, private, Bible study tour.

Please Note: Transfers are not included unless you are taking our optional air program or can arrive before the group. If you make your own flight arrangements or book outside of the optional group air, you may be responsible for obtaining your transfer to and from our starting and ending destinations.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Proper Documentation

All members of this tour must carry passports valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return. This means your passport must be valid at least through November 26, 2021, or longer if you choose to extend your trip. If you need information regarding obtaining or renewing your passport, contact Living Passages (herein known as LP).

Air Tickets

Re-issuance of tickets that must be changed or reissued for any reason, may be subject to charges or fees by the carriers and/or other vendors; such fees may be substantial. In the event of cancellations and if you have to fly differently due to unforeseen circumstances (weather, etc.) or take special transfers, costs incurred might be reimbursed by insurance. Call for pricing. Airfare is included from Portland, Oregon. If you wish to meet us in Athens, you can take an air credit of \$1,230 per person. This is the air credit flying into Athens and returning from either Rome if doing the extension or from Athens if you are taking the core trip. If you want to meet the group at the airport and want to take our airport transfers, please arrive on April 20, 2021 no later than 11:00AM. On April 26, 2021 we are currently scheduled to depart the Athens hotel at 5:30AM. If you are arranging your airfare yourself AND taking the Rome extension, we will depart the Rome hotel at 6:30AM on April 26, 2021. We can quote business class prices.

Limitations

The air carrier(s), group operators and LP reserve right to substitute equipment and properties and to add or delete en route stops at our discretion with or without notice. The hotels, cruise line, ground operators and other vendors used by LP reserve the right, in special circumstances, to substitute accommodations/transportation and sights of similar or better quality without penalty.

The cruise line is operated by Celestyal Cruise Lines. If our group is smaller than 35, we will be with other cruise guests on our 3 tours during the ship sailing: Ephesus, Crete and Patmos. Thank you for understanding that we are obligated to abide by their rules.

Singles

We match roommates! If you are a single person or traveling alone, we do have others who would like to travel with us without paying the single supplement. We assign roommates approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. We cannot guarantee it, but it has worked well for many.

Making Your Deposit/Reservations

- If depositing prior to January 19, 2021, a deposit of \$750 per person is due (plus insurance) and your signed registration form. If booking after January 19, 2021 - full payment is due within 7 days of your registration. Payments not received by the due day are subject to a 5% monthly finance charge and possible cancellation of reservation.
- Please note we will continue to take bookings and reservations until our departure, as long as space is available and we will do everything possible to make sure you can join us!
- You may always, if you wish, use a credit card for your initial deposit and insurance and then pay the balance with cash or check and still receive the full cash discount.

Changes/Revisions

We will try to accommodate name changes, but additional fees may be imposed and passed on by the carriers. If specific rooming requests are altered due to cancellation by one or more passengers, the passenger(s) still traveling may be required to pay the resulting applicable occupancy rate. Trip insurance may cover this additional cost.

Cancellation and Refunds

In the event that you must cancel your reservation, or payments are not received by specified deadlines, refunds are made in accordance with the following schedule. Please keep in mind that if any airline tickets are issued, they are generally nonrefundable (unless trip cancellation insurance is purchased and provides refunds). All cancellations received after booking and deposit will incur an \$130 administrative fee plus the per person cancellation fee below, if notice is received:

- 158-120 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$490 per person, plus any air costs incurred on your behalf, including air add-ons from domestic cities, pre- or post-options, and insurance or add-on travel you have purchased. Note, air add-ons are usually always nonrefundable, which is why insurance is strongly recommended.
- 119-98 days or more prior to departure, the cancellation fee is under a 35-percent penalty per person, plus any air costs incurred, pre- or post-options, and insurance or add-on travel you have purchased.
- 97 days and less the trip becomes nonrefundable. Trip insurance is highly recommended.
- Travel insurance premiums (and airfare) are always non-refundable

Responsibility

Living Passages via Warren Community Fellowship / WCF (herein all called LP) has the responsibility of booking with airlines, hotels, boat and ferry companies, ground operators and tour guides to provide you with these services. The carriers, hotels, and other suppliers providing tour services are independent contractors and are not agents, employees, or servants of, or joint ventures with LP or its affiliates. All certificates and other travel documents for tour services issued by LP are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the supplier, and to the laws of the countries in which the services are supplied. Each participant agrees not to hold LP liable, in the absence of its own negligence, for any loss, act or omission, whether negligent or otherwise, of any person or firm which is to, or does provide goods or services for the trip and shall have no liability to the participant for the quality of services or the condition or cleanliness of accommodations or for any transportation delay, including but not limited to liability for inconvenience, shortened vacation time, additional expense, or any other kind of damage. LP is not responsible for government actions, weather, mechanical breakdowns, war, terrorism, acts of nature (secularly known as "Acts of God",) changes in ship or accommodation or other circumstances beyond its control. If a travel ban is imposed by the United States on any country we are scheduled to tour, another destination will be substituted. In the event of delay, the airline or tour company and not LP, determines delay procedures and the amenities/compensation, if any, to be offered. LP will not accept responsibility for additional charges incurred for expenses or lost wages as a result of changes to flight times, and/or missed vacation time.

Activities

Participants may choose to engage in various activities including, but not limited to, camel riding, hiking, swimming and other "activities"; participants are hereby notified that these and other activities may be dangerous and may result in a serious injury and that participation in these activities shall be at the participant's own risk. LP shall not be liable for any injuries sustained by cruise/tour participants, which are a result of participant's engaging in such activities.

Fuel Surcharges, Fees or Taxes

It is possible that the ground, bus, boat and ferry companies and other operators will bill LP for additional fuel surcharges, fees and or other taxes. You will be notified quickly and prior to being billed for final payment if any vendors make any of these types of increases. You may arrange your own air travel.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Currency and Special Provisions

Pricing of the ground portions, cruise and the tour was based on currency that was in effect on April 15, 2020. You will be notified as far in advance as possible in the event the price of the tour needs to be adjusted. We do not foresee this happening, but in today's economic climate, we have to be prepared for any currency discontinuation or devaluation that can affect any of the countries we visit, transit or to which we provide governance. We will do everything possible to not allow this to happen but we have to be mindful of the world's current political environment.

Travelers Who Need Special Assistance

LP must be advised of a participant's special requirements at the time of booking and we will make every effort to accommodate special requests but cannot confirm a reservation until all travel suppliers have acknowledged that they can provide the services requested. Our bus in Greece is suited for someone who may need to use a wheelchair. We do need to know when taking bookings if this is the case.

Safety

The safety of passengers is a primary concern of Living Passages but also of the owners and operators of the vessels, aircraft, ground transportation, and other facilities being used. If safety is threatened by any factors the owners/operators of other facilities and services reserve the right to make whatever changes to the itinerary or schedule they deem necessary for the safety of all.

Major Changes

"Major changes" constitute only changes in the departure city and/or departure dates by more than 48 hours, hotel substitutions of lower quality. If LP first knows of a major change less than 21 days before scheduled departure, LP's liability is limited to a full refund excluding insurance and any other nonrefundable airfare paid. For extensions, LP contracts with certain hotels to supply accommodation. Occasionally, the accommodation reserved is not available for a variety of reasons (i.e. unexpected maintenance problems, guest stay-overs, and over-booking by the hotel) and a substitute hotel of equal or greater quality is provided. In the event of your hotel standard being substantially downgraded, a refund reflecting the difference in price will be issued. A change in currency or exchange is not considered a major change. The governing laws of the State of Idaho shall prevail and any dispute may be resolved in the City of Coeur d'Alene by means of arbitration. The prevailing party of any dispute will be entitled to recuperate pertinent legal fees and costs from the other party.

360° Travel Protection (Trip Insurance)

Your payment for the optional insurance, due with your deposit, covers the cost of the 360° Group Premium Travel Protection Plan. Your 360° Travel Protection description of coverage will be sent to you along with the receipt of your deposit. The travel protection plan is underwritten by Berkshire Hathaway Specialty Insurance Company, a company located in Omaha, NE with NAIC # 22276, and designed by Travelex Insurance Services. Coverage includes reimbursement for trip cancellation for covered reasons such as death of a family member, accident or sickness that prevents you from traveling, reimbursement for emergency medical expenses, emergency medical evacuation/repatriation, travel delay and loss of baggage. This group plan is based on a minimum of 10 total enrollees in the group opting to include this insurance in their package. You may request a copy of the Description of Coverage prior to purchase by contacting Living Passages. Policies that allow cancellation for any reason are available but for a higher premium. If you feel you need more flexible coverage, contact LP. If you are traveling with children under the age of 18, we have family policies available. Please contact us for a quote.
