**October 2:** Depart Portland or home airport  
Current schedule departs at 9:30 AM.

### October 3: Istanbul!

Arrive Istanbul at 4:00 PM. Transfer to the lovely Eresein boutique hotel in the Old City of Istanbul. Three blocks from the hotel is the Blue Mosque, Hagia Sofia and Topkapi Palace. You can also obtain your own airfare and arrive in Istanbul earlier. Dinner.

### October 4: Flight to Cappadocia

Depart the hotel for your morning flight to Cappadocia. After lunch, tour the Underground City and stay in a very unique "cave" boutique hotel amidst this intriguing landscape. [BLD]

**October 5: Kayseri and Cappadocia** - *Optional balloon adventure this morning for those who wish to participate.*

Walk the whimsical churches. Time for unique shopping and meandering the quaint walkways. This morning there will be an optional sunrise excursion available, where you can take a ballooning trip above beautiful volcanic landscapes. The region is also a world heritage site rich with Byzantine art, underground towns & troglodyte villages of the Göreme Valley; all visible from the quiet of a hot air balloon. [BLD]



### October 6: Fly to the Mediterranean Sea, Pergamon – Bergama

This morning fly to the modern town of Izmir located on the sea. Transfer to the quaint town of Bergama where we will have a nice lunch in this colorful town. Today we tour the site of Pergamon and the Askleion and famous Red Court. Interestingly it is the Askleion where modern medicine (pharmacology) represents itself amongst the Greek "gods". The site at Pergamon is accessed via a funicular tram with stunning views of the Mediterranean basin. Pergamon's famous altar was taken to Berlin where it is still located today. The altar has been used and duplicated by various politicians in the modern eras. Overnight at a boutique hotel with time to rest and explore this ancient city. [BLD]

### October 7: Thyatira, Smyrna

Today, visit the church sites of Thyatira and Smyrna. At Smyrna we will study the story of Polycarp and see the area where he lived. Afterwards, overnight at the lovely Swiss Hotel Izmir with a splendid fish dinner. Izmir is considered the San Diego of Western Turkey. [BLD]

### October 8: Seven Churches of Revelation site of Sardis, Laodicea, Colossae, overnight at its thermal pools.

After our sumptuous breakfast you will arrive at the church site of Sardis. Study time here amongst the incredible antiquity. Next, we arrive at the small – but remaining site of the church of Philadelphia. More time of study and reflection and then a fun lunch at the Marla Club before we drive over the mountains. After a time of refreshment, we arrive one of the most impressive stones of the Churches of Revelation – the site of Laodicea. Later in the day, visit the site of Colossae and then on to our hotel. Once at the hotel, we can wrap up in thick robes and head down to the hotel's private Turkish baths and thermal pools that originate at the cascading Colossae archaeological site. We will stay at one of the hot springs hotels, so be sure to bring your swimming attire. Dinner is included. **[BLD]**

### October 9: Hierapolis, Seven Churches of Revelation site of Ephesus, return to Mediterranean Sea.

This morning, we walk through the site of Hierapolis – with hundreds and hundreds of amazing tombs. Drive back through the mountains with a stop at a local artisan's village for lunch. The site of all sites is visited today, Ephesus! Ephesus is considered the top archaeological site in the Mediterranean. You will be able to walk the streets that the Apostles John, Paul and Timothy walked, and you will be in the city where Jesus' mother, Mary lived out her final days. There is an opportunity for shopping this afternoon. Dinner at the hotel this evening. **[BLD]**

### October 10: Didyma

Tour of Didyma today. Note the circle of cities surrounding the Aegean Sea that the Apostles visited frequently and where the Early Church thrived. We fly to Istanbul around dinner time where you will walk within the terminal to your tiny hotel rooms with all the amenities you need for a good night's rest. They call it "Yotel". The all-new Istanbul airport is like a small city with shopping and restaurants galore. [BL]

### October 11: Return flight to Portland or your home city

Depart Istanbul today at 6:20 AM, transferring in Seattle and arriving in Portland.

### October 11: Flight to Rome, Christian Catacombs

Depart Istanbul at 0845AM this morning nonstop to Rome. On arrival in Rome, you will be met by your tour host and guide. You will have an opportunity to grab a piece of Italian pizza or sandwich prior to arrival to the area of Rome where many of the new believers lived inside the ancient catacombs. It is also in this area where Priscilla and Aquila had a home. Next, visit the church where Paul's body is laid. Arrive at your hotel located in the center of Rome. Dinner at the hotel. [BD]

### October 12: Vatican, Ancient Rome

Early visit to the Vatican this morning along with St. Peter's Basilica. Afterwards transfer to the center of Rome for a private tour of the prison cell of Paul and Peter at the Forum. Visit the Forum and Nero's tomb and tour of the Coliseum. Walking tour of Rome with Trevi Fountain and the Parthenon. Free evening for shopping. [B]

### October 13: Rome – Free day

After breakfast we visit the Apostle Paul's home church of Regola. It is located in the oldest section of Jewish Rome called Trastevere. It is an extremely rare visit for tourists. Afterward, enjoy lunch on your own at the Piazza de Fiori – the plaza of flowers. You have free time this afternoon to visit the Spanish Steps and its long shopping streets, the Via Veneto, the numerous monuments and churches, gelatos and pizzerias of Rome. The options are endless.

### October 14: Flights Home

Departing late morning at 10:30 AM back to Portland or your home airport.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Proper Documentation

All members of this tour must carry passports valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return. Please note that there may be a requirement for tests or other requirements by the airlines, the TSA, bus companies, hotels, the countries to which you are traveling and/or other governing parties. We have no way of knowing what that requirement will be when you travel. In the event there is a medical treatment or injection or test (or other) of any kind required for this trip, or any other health requirement, please note that the vendors will have already accepted your booking knowing there is a current global threat. Therefore, if you book this tour, you are accepting the terms of the airlines, the TSA, the hotels, the transportation companies, the countries to which you are traveling and/or other governing parties without fully knowing what they will be by the time you travel.

### Air Tickets

There is an air block from Portland, or you can purchase your own round-trip international airfare. Air will still be provided on the three flights that are included within Turkey. It is preferred that you travel with the group if you can so that you can have airport transfers included, but you have the freedom to arrange your own international air. If you do take the air credit, it is \$1,050 per person. Reissuance of tickets that must be changed or reissued for any reason, may be subject to charges or fees by the carriers and/or other vendors; such fees may be substantial. Fuel surcharges can be implemented in these current financial times. Note, they will need to be paid if they announce them.

October 3: Arrive in Istanbul at 4:00PM or anytime prior if you wish to use our transfers.

October 11: Depart Istanbul at 4:10AM or any time after if you wish to use our transfers.

October 14: Depart Rome at 10:30AM or any time after if you wish to use our transfers.

### Limitations

The air carrier(s), group operators and LP reserve right to substitute equipment and properties and to add or delete en route stops at our discretion with or without notice. The hotels, airlines, ground operators and other vendors used by LP reserve the right, in special circumstances, to substitute accommodations/transportation and sights of similar or better quality without penalty. Minimum group size is 10, and with less than 16, the pricing may increase as high as 15%.

### Singles

We match roommates! If you are a single person or traveling alone, we do have others who would like to travel with us without paying the single supplement. We assign roommates approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. We cannot guarantee it, but it has worked well for many.

### Making Your Deposit / Reservations

• If depositing prior to July 15, 2022, a non-refundable deposit of \$450 per person is due (plus optional travel insurance) and your signed registration form. Final payment is due July 15, 2022. If booking after July 15, 2022 - full payment is due within 7 days of your registration.

Payments not received by the due date are subject to a 5% monthly finance charge and possible cancellation of reservation.

• Please note we will continue to take bookings and reservations until our departure, as long as space is available, and we will do everything possible to make sure you can join us!

• You may use a credit card for your initial deposit and optional insurance and then pay the balance with cash or check and still receive the full cash discount.

### Changes / Revisions

No name changes are allowed. This unique trip will have prepaid airfare that does not allow name changes (and they also are nonrefundable). If specific rooming requests are altered due to cancellation by one or more passengers, the passenger(s) still traveling may be required to pay the resulting applicable occupancy rate. Trip insurance may cover this additional cost.

### Cancellation and Refunds

In the event that you must cancel your reservation, or payments are not received by specified deadlines, refunds are made in accordance with the following schedule. All cancellations received after booking and deposit will forfeit the \$450 deposit. We are issuing airline tickets at the time you book your tour, and they are nonrefundable. Closer to departure:

• 68 days to 46 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$2450 for the main tour and \$1090 for the Rome post extension per person, plus any additional costs incurred, pre- or post-options, and insurance or add on travel you have purchased.

• 45 days and less the trip becomes nonrefundable.

Please know that credits transferred from another tour are subject to the nonrecoverable costs in place at the time of transfer. These funds will remain nonrefundable.

If you accept the travel insurance offered, any insurance premium paid is nonrefundable if you have filed a claim, plan to file a claim, or have departed on your trip. Airfare is always non-refundable.

### Responsibility

LP has the responsibility of booking with airlines, hotels, transportation vehicles, ground operators and tour guides to provide you with these services. The carriers, hotels, and other suppliers providing tour services are independent contractors and are not agents, employees, or servants of, or joint ventures with LP or its affiliates. All certificates and other travel documents for tour services issued by LP are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the supplier, and to the laws of the countries in which the services are supplied. Each participant agrees not to hold LP liable, in the absence of its own negligence, for any loss, act or omission, whether negligent or otherwise, of any person or firm which is to, or does provide goods or services for the trip and shall have no liability to the participant for the quality of services or the condition or cleanliness of accommodations or for any transportation delay, including but not limited to liability for inconvenience, shortened vacation time, additional expense, or any other kind of damage. LP is not responsible for government actions, weather, mechanical breakdowns, war, terrorism, acts of nature (secularly known as "Acts of God"), denying entrance to a site due to political or other reasons or other circumstances beyond its control. If a travel ban is imposed by the United States on any country, we are scheduled to tour, we will attempt to secure another destination. We cannot be held accountable due to political decisions. In the event of delay, the airline or tour company and not LP, determines delay procedures and the amenities/compensation, if any, to be offered. LP will not accept responsibility for additional charges incurred for expenses or lost wages as a result of changes to flight times, and/or missed vacation time.



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Activities

Participants may choose to engage in various activities including, but not limited to, camel riding, hiking, swimming and other "activities", participants are hereby notified that these and other activities may be dangerous and may result in a serious injury and that participation in these activities shall be at the participant's own risk. Living Passages (herein referred to as LP) shall not be liable for any injuries sustained by cruise/tour participants, which are a result of participant's engaging in such activities.

### Travelers Who Need Special Assistance

LP must be advised of a participant's special requirements at the time of booking and we will make every effort to accommodate special requests but cannot confirm a reservation until all travel suppliers have acknowledged that they can provide the services requested.

### Prepaid Tips

Prepaid tips to the guide are the minimum amounts. If an amazing job is done, an additional form of gratitude would be very appreciated. There will also be tips to guides and private meals outside of our group for which we will provide some tipping. Suggestions and guidelines will be mailed to you with your documents.

### Fuel Surcharges, Fees or Taxes

It is possible that the ground, vehicles, governments, visa providers or facilitators and other operators will bill LP for additional fuel surcharges, fees and other taxes. You will be notified quickly and prior to being billed for final payment if any vendors make any of these types of increases. You may arrange your own air travels.

### Currency and Special Provisions

Pricing of tour and event was based on currency that was in effect on March 2, 2022. You will be notified as far in advance as possible in the event the price of the tour needs to be adjusted. We do not foresee this happening, but in today's economic climate, we have to be prepared for any currency discontinuation or devaluation or "reset" that can affect any of the countries we visit, transit or to which we provide governance. We will do everything possible to not allow this to happen but we have to be mindful of the world's current political environment.

### Safety

The safety of passengers is a primary concern of LP but also of the owners and operators of the vessels, aircraft, ground transportation, and other facilities being used. If safety is threatened by any factors the owners/ operators of other facilities and services reserve the right to make whatever changes to the itinerary or schedule they deem necessary for the safety of all.

In the event of danger or war, we will do all possible to facilitate a change of dates, destinations and vendor refunds. It all depends on timing and geography. There is never a set standard of operation. In 20 years, we have never seen an entirely negative outcome for a group. But we do live in interesting times.

### Major Changes

Destinations and the sites offered here can be withdrawn at any time by government restrictions and other reasons beyond our control. COVID blamed cancellations (or any of the new disease or injected related creations), postponements and such of any kind are not the responsibility of LP. You are booking the trip at your own risk and penalties will not be waived.

If LP first knows of a major change less than 21 days before scheduled departure, LP's liability is limited to refunds that we can obtain on your behalf excluding insurance and any other nonrefundable airfare paid or visa fees, and non-recoverable costs from our vendors but not for any COVID or other named health or vaccination mandate.
